The DEADLINE molluscicide products from AMVAC provide excellent slug and snail control across multiple crop types. DEADLINE® M-Ps $^{\text{\tiny{M}}}$, DEADLINE® GT $^{\text{\tiny{M}}}$ and DEADLINE® Bullets $^{\text{\tiny{M}}}$ all utilize the same active ingredient, but provide different features and benefits depending on your operation's needs.
