ACROPOLIS — The Power in Soybean Fungicides

ACROPOLIS brings two effective modes of action for the control of white mold infestations in soybeans.

ACROPOLIS combines two top-rated active ingredients: tetraconazole and thiophanate-methyl. In 2017 trials, ACROPOLIS provided substantial disease reduction of white mold, delivering yield benefits over untreated control and competitive standards. Locally systemic, ACROPOLIS provides crop-safe control of white mold for up to 21 days. In most situations, one well-timed application of ACROPOLIS can control moderate to heavy infestations of white mold.

ACROPOLIS Rate for White Mold in Soybeans (23 fl oz/A)

- Apply at early bloom (R1 soybean growth stage)
- Make a 2nd application after 14 days when environmental conditions are favorable to continued disease development
- Apply a minimum of 10 gallons of spray suspension per acre by ground sprayer or in a minimum of 5 gallons of spray suspension per acre by aircraft
- Full coverage of the flowers, stems and branches is required for disease control
- ACROPOLIS label allows two applications per season
- In addition to white mold, ACROPOLIS also controls: anthracnose, brown spot, frogeye leaf spot, purple seed stain, pod and stem blight, powdery mildew and Asian soybean rust; refer to the label for application and use rates
