Anthracnose Blossom blight/brown rot Scab Shothole	4 pt./A OR 1.33 pt./100 gal.	25 pints per acre, per year	For blossom blight, begin application at popcorn (pink bud) and follow with an application at full bloom. If weather is still conducive for disease development, another application may be made at petal fall. For control of shothole, make an application in the autumn at leaf fall. In the spring, make the first application at budbreak, followed by an application at shuck split to control nut infections and to control scab. Apply by ground or air. Do not apply within 150 days of harvest.
